Those alumni are among the multitude of PGA TOUR winners who rose to stardom after graduating from the Korn Ferry Tour.

The Korn Ferry Tour will shape the foundation of future Presidents Cup teams, produce another No. 1 player in the Official World Golf Ranking, and prepare the next FedExCup champion and major championship winners. The road to those future achievements runs through the Korn Ferry Tour. As PGA TOUR Commissioner Jay Monahan declared, the Korn Ferry Tour is golf's ultimate proving ground.

You are joining us at an exciting time in our 36-year history, as the Korn Ferry Tour continues to attract a robust group of international members, in addition to emerging talents and future PGA TOUR winners through PGA TOUR University.

The 2025 Korn Ferry Tour season will be one of the most competitive in our history, with our membership competing for 20 PGA TOUR cards across 26 events contested in seven countries.

Team approach to comprehensive care

- Care for children with disorders of the hematologic system, including white blood cell, red blood cell and platelets.
- Comprehensive pediatric hematology and oncology requires a multidisciplinary team approach.
- Individualized oncology care that places the patient and family at the center of this team, surrounded by pediatric-specialized physicians, nurses, physical and occupational therapists, social workers, pharmacists and child life specialists.
- Complimentary outpatient and inpatient resources that encompass every aspect of pediatric hematology and oncology service.

Services

- Outpatient hematology and oncology clinic for new hematology referrals, and off-therapy oncology patients.
- Outpatient chemotherapy infusion and sedation center for oncology patients receiving chemotherapy and children requiring infusions.
- Inpatient consultative service where we are at the bedside every day working in collaboration with the comprehensive team to provide an evidence-based standard of care.



PATIENT STORY

"Our daughter, Reese, was diagnosed with Very High Risk pre-B-cell Acute Lymphoblastic Leukemia the day before her fourth birthday. Reese started chemotherapy with Dr. Hall and his team at Wesley Children's Hospital. She did not get into remission after two cycles of chemo, which meant she would need a bone marrow transplant. They used a newer medication (immunotherapy) that no one else in Wichita has used and it got her into remission. She was then able to go to Children's Mercy Hospital in Kansas City for her bone marrow transplant. Since Children's Mercy knew what detailed care she would receive in Wichita, they released her quickly after her transplant. Reese is receiving exceptional care in Wichita, so our trips to Kansas City have been few and far between. We are blessed to be able to spend time together at home instead of on the road." – April and Josh Horn
